Hayley Woodward (RAD RTS) - Principal



Miss Hayley has been the principal of Inspiration Dance Academy since 2008. Her goal was always to form a school with a safe and nurturing environment for all students and to grow what she now calls her IDA family.

Hayley studied performing arts and danced under the direction of the highly recognised Sarah Boulter and Lisa Bowmer and is a graduate from a full time performing arts course at the highly respected Ev & Bow Fulltime Performing Arts School.

Since the age of 3 years old the passion for dancing has been the inspiration that has lead to many great achievements for Hayley. As a young student Hayley auditioned and became a member of both the 2001 American Tour Group and the 2005 World Tour Group, which then gave her the opportunity to study under some of the most prestigious teachers and choreographers throughout the world.

Her achievements as a young dancer have given her much respect in her field. Just to name a few, in 2004 & 2005 Hayley was a finalist in the prestigious Australian Dance Idol Competition held in Sydney with hundreds of competitors and she was in the final 10. In 2005 Hayley was the highest scoring competitor in the regional showcase championships, winning all dance sections in the showcase.

In 2007 Hayley was placed 1st in the state by the NSW Board of Studies for her dance HSC which was an extremely prestigious achievement and was awarded to her by Morris Iemma, and highly publicised throughout the media.

In 2008 Hayley was a finalist in the Open Age Contemporary McDonalds Performing Arts section that is of the highest standard in Australia. Also she was a member of the \$5000 winning piece for the highly prestigious "Dance of the Champions" held at the Science Theatre Sydney University. This competition involves more than 500 elite dancers.

Hayley has a love of choreography and has put together many pieces for championships and scholarships at many eisteddfods around Sydney and Wollongong with outstanding results. Also she is responsible for choreographing school dance ensemble pieces throughout the shire and local areas.

Hayley has been involved in many performing arts productions including modelling and acting such as 2008 Luna Park Sydney commercial, "Cassie Davis film clip" "Town Hall Steps - Disco Film Clip" "De Ja Vu Cabaret" "The Wrong Show" and appearing in "Underbelly 3" and "Home & Away"

Hayley has also completed her Royal Academy Of Dance, Certificate in Teaching Ballet Studies and is a registered teacher of the Royal Academy of Dance along with sending many students through their exams. She has also taken many courses such as the professional Zumba instructor course and can't wait to share her knowledge with you.

Important in this industry is Hayley's contacts in the performing arts fields and her enthusiasm to assist students in finding areas that can expand on their passion for performing.

To further her career Hayley has attained a Diploma and certificate IV in dance teaching and management. Miss Hayley is so looking forward to another year of working with the students to make a fun, safe and rewarding experience for all involved and looks forward to passing on her love of dance and the performing arts!

UNIFORMS:

"Inspiration Dance Academy has a compulsory uniform policy."

Failure to comply with this policy may result in the need for disciplinary action. Hair must be pulled back neatly and secure for every class. It is compulsory for all ballet students in classes Beginner and above to wear their hair in a bun. All Ballet students must be wearing a leotard to class.

Grooming is an important part of a child's training in the areas of pride and attitude. Inspiration Dance Academy believes the students also benefit from a team uniform.

Inspiration Dance Academy uniforms are sold each year at the studio. There is a choice of different styles such as leotards, tights, shorts, crossovers and jackets. We will send out a letter for orders in February if you would like to purchase any of these items. Please see Miss Hayley if you would like to look at some samples.

Demonstration Day which is held mid year has a compulsory uniform and this can be worn throughout the year to classes. Demonstration Day Compulsory uniform can be seen on the next page.

DEMONSTRATION DAY COMPULSORY UNIFORMS:

Demonstration Day is not a concert but a demonstration of the children's class work. The children will display on stage the class work that they have been working on throughout the year. They will be presented with an award at the presentation for their participation and hard work.

This will be a wonderful opportunity for parents, grandparents, family and friends to come and watch what each child has been working towards for the first half of the year.

DEMONSTRATION AND CONCERT DAY:

Inspiration Dance Academy holds an annual demonstration day and also an end of year concert performance. These performances give the chance for each student to perform for their family and friends as well as showing their progress throughout the year.

All students are involved in both the demonstration day and concert performance. It is an absolute must that if you are unable to perform in either of these you specify in writing before 1st April otherwise you will still incur the costume cost as this will be purchased on your behalf.

Costumes will not be handed out to families until costumes payments and term 4 fees have been paid in full. Students will not be able to participate in the end of year concert until all outstanding accounts have been paid in full.

Photography and Videography are not permitted at our end of year concerts. A professional videographer will be present at this event if you would like to purchase a DVD. An order form will be sent closer to the date.

COSTUME DEPOSITS:

Inspiration Dance Academy will hold their annual concert closer to the end of the year. Costume deposits are a way of spreading out your payments over the year. I am very aware this time of year can be very costly so I divide the payment into a first deposit and final payment.

The first costume deposits will be collected separate to your fees between the 1st May - 30th May. This way we are able to purchase materials and costumes in preparation for the concert.

Please make sure all payments are in an envelope clearly labelled and given to your child's teacher.

Costumes will not be handed out to families until costume payments and term 4 fees have been finalised. Children get to keep all costumes they have purchased.

COLLECTION AND DROP OFF OF STUDENTS:

It is at all times the responsibility of parents and guardians to ensure students are delivered and collected to classes safely, on time and not left unsupervised.

Also we do have a small waiting room where parents and students can wait but students must be supervised at all times.

Inspiration Dance academy is not responsible for your children before and after their respective classes.

CLASS DISCIPLINE POLICY:

The teachers of Inspiration Dance Academy will follow our class discipline policy within our school.

SECURITY:

All Inspiration Dance Academy studios are fitted with security cameras in the classroom and waiting areas. This is for the protection of all Inspiration Dance Academy students.

RECEIVING INFORMATION;

Inspiration Dance Academy operates electronically. Information and notes will be sent weekly via email. It is important to ensure you keep the dance academy up to date with your correct contact information. Information will also be posted on our website, Facebook and Instagram pages.

EXAMS:

At Inspiration Dance Academy we take part in Royal Academy of Dance, ballet exams and Glenn Wood Tap, tap exams for those students interested.

These exams are a great way for students to work at this particular style of dance and then be examined on their work. Students often progress at different rates and are prepared for examinations only when Inspiration teachers and principal agree the student shows a level of competence required to undertake the examination. This decision will be made by the principal and teacher in accordance with RAD and Glenn Wood Tap Code of Practices.

At Inspiration Dance Academy we endeavour to have our students to reach a standard that allows them to present themselves for these exams (Should they wish to). It is a general guide students need to complete a minimum of 2 classes of ballet per week (for ballet exams) and 1 hour of tap per week (for tap exams) for 1-1.5 years to reach a standard that makes them eligible to be considered for either of these exams.

To be considered for an exam the student must show commitment and good attendance. All students will need the proper uniform requirement for these exams. Students in Grade 1-5 will also need their own character skirt and character shoes.

PERFORMANCE STREAM CLASSES:

The Inspiration Dance Academy Performance Stream is a group of dancers that will be expected to represent Inspiration Dance Academy in various events and competitions and eisteddfods.

The fee for the Performance Stream is a one off fee of \$190.00 for 2022, which covers the classes and entry fees to competitions. You will also be expected to purchase a costume for the dances, which will be finalised in term 1.

Requirements for performance stream:

- 8/under and 10/under Performance Stream: Must participate in one Jazz class per week
- 12/under, 14/under and 15/over: Must participate in one Jazz class AND one ballet class per week

Being part of the Performance Stream is a great opportunity for the child to perform as a team player and excel in their dance training. It also gives the students the extra performance time throughout the year. At Inspiration Dance Academy we encourage everyone to enjoy themselves and also act as a great role model and sportsperson within the dance studios and local community.

In 2021 all performance streams will be learning a lyrical or contemporary routine and a jazz routine.

Compulsory attendance and commitment will be required. If you believe you have the time, commitment and passion please contact Miss Hayley for an application form.
